- g. <u>Safety/Risk Management Committee</u> (Chair Alex Lazorisak). Commissioner Lazorisak mentioned that Salem County had just been hit with a cyber-attack, and stated that Warren County had suffered similar attempts targeting their VPN lines. A discussion regarding cyber training followed. GC/Co-Admin Nemeth reminded Members of the availability of training through the NJIIF's consultant, D2 cybersecurity.
- h. Member & Development Committee (Chair Maureen Chumacas) No Report.
- 7. <u>Risk Manager's Report</u> (Polaris Galaxy). J. Gallo reported that property cyber renewal is underway, and also announced that the 2024 Policy Package would be circulated to all

- Members and Risk Managers. Additionally, he reported that his office is working with Cbiz on determining the schedule for the 2024 round of property assessments.
- 8. <u>Director of Marketing Report</u> (Barlas). A. Barlas reported that he met with J. Gallo (Risk Manager); they are planning for this year's renewals, as well as targeting potential new municipalities for membership.
- 9. Loss Control Consultant Report (PMA/T. Wier). Tim Weir reported that PMA provided direct risk control services to 8 members this month, including but not limited to safety meetings, loss cause focus issues, etc. Additionally, J. Matthews has arranged for a chainsaw education program on April 11th, hosted by the Township of Wayne and provided by a Stihl authorized trainer. T. Weir also reported that February is Heart Health Month, which is important to recognize given the potential risks in the workplace.

10. <u>TPA Report</u> (PMA./J. Signs). J. Signs provided an update on aggregate WC claims received through 2/1/24, including the number of COVID cases. She reported that total claims reported in 2024 were lower than for the same period in 2023. Signs also indicated that total incurred losses for 2024 were below the 5-year average. Finally, Signs explained that the NJIIF has a total of 419 reported COVID cases with 104 related claim petitions filed to date, and noted that no new COVID claims have been received this year.
