Weir reported that PMA has provided assistance regarding PEOSH inspections and Notices of Orders to Comply received by several members. In addition, PMA held a "Designated Employee Representative" seminar through Dynamic Testing Service on May 23rd in Maplewood with 9 members attending. T. Weir advised that their June Safety Seen newsletter was distributed and focuses on the annual "Firefighter Safety Stand Down", Slips, Trips and Falls, and hurricane season preparation.

It was reported that total claims in 2024 are somewhat higher than the 5 year average, however the total incurred losses for 2024 thus far are well below the 5-year average.
